All completed essays need to be turned into Mr. Dymont by Monday November 27, 2017. DO NOT TURN IN YOUR ESSAY TO EITHER MR. GOCHA OR MRS. SHERR. All entrants will be notified if they have or have not received a scholarship.

Writing Prompt:

What are you hoping to learn while in DC, and how will you use this knowledge in the future? If given the opportunity to participate, how will you extend your goodwill to others, meaning, how will you *pay it forward*? Don't forget to do your best, explain yourself fully, and be honest.
