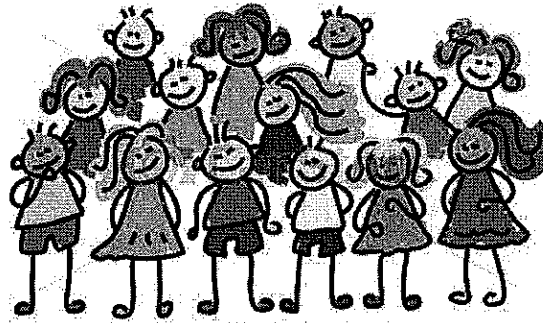

- One small spiral notebook labeled *Social Studies*
- One pocket folder to be used for social studies assignments/ handouts.
- Pencils, with your name or initials written on each one in ink or a permanent marker. *(We realize this takes some time to do, but it saves a lot of time in the long run, searching for missing or misplaced pencils.)*

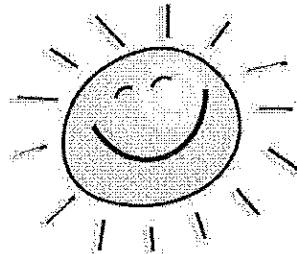
Additional items that are not required but have proven to be extremely helpful are:
